Dear Second Grade Parents,

September has quickly arrived and it is now time for our students to begin homework in their Reading Log. This will be an additional part of their daily homework routine. Students will be <u>reading aloud</u> to a parent or guardian for <u>15</u> <u>minutes each homework day</u> in order to perfect their fluency, expressive skills, and comprehension. It is an <u>oral reading log</u>, and your attention, modeling correct pronunciation, and inquiry into their understanding of the content during this time will be invaluable in strengthening and perfecting your child's skill and confidence in reading.

Please look for the Reading Log to come home in September. It should be returned back to school at the end of each month on the date listed in the log along with the completed book report for the month. The book report may be completed at any time during the month on any one of the books logged during the month.
